It has excluded certain establishments providing essential services from the shutdown which includes Stock Exchanges, Clearing Corporations, Stock Brokers and SEBI registered participants operating through these Institutions.

In view of the same, National Commodity & Derivatives Exchange Limited and National Commodity Clearing Limited will function normally. As Trading and Clearing Members are also excluded, they are required to take note of the same.

AMENDED ORDER UNDER RULE-10 FOR SOCIAL DISTANCING

This order supersedes all earlier orders

WHEREAS the Government of Maharashtra, in exercise of the power conferred under section 2, 3 & 4 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897 has framed Regulations for prevention and containment of COVID-19 under No. Corona 2020/ CR/ 58/ Aarogya-5 dated 13th March 2020,

AND WHEREAS under rule 10 of the said Regulation, the Municipal Commissioner is authorized to take any measures for containment of COVID-19,


I, Praveen Pardeshi, Municipal Commissioner of Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai, in exercise of said powers conferred upon me hereby direct under rule 10 of the said Regulation to implement the following containment measures in the City of Mumbai until further orders.

1. Restricting the vehicular movement in the areas of Isolation Centres, Quarantine Centres, declared by MCGM like Kasturba Hospital, KEM Hospital, Seven Hills Hospital.
2. Closure of schools, cinema halls, swimming pools, gyms., Malls / Mill compound, Spa Centres, Clubs, Pubs, Discotheques, SGNP, Amusement Parks, etc. and banning mass congregations, functions.
3. Restaurants, Cafes, Eateries and Dhabas may continue if they can self-impose 50% customer capacity and maintain distance of 3 feet between each customer.
4. All private, Corporates and establishments to be completely shut down. However, following establishments providing essential services shall be excluded -
 - Providing drinking water
 - Providing sewerage services
 - Providing Banking and other services regulated by and RBI, Insurance Companies
 - Providing Telephone and Internet Services
 - Providing Rail and Transportation Services
 - Providing Food, Vegetable, Groceries
 - Hospitals, Medical centres, Medical stores
 - Electricity, Petroleum, Oil, Energy
 - Media
 - Port

- IT Services, IT enabled Services and Data Centres needed for continuity of IT Services to the essential services.
 - Ongoing Public Infrastructure Projects wherever Development of Water, Sewerage, Transportation, Roads is involved.
 - Stock Exchange, Clearing Corporations, Depositories, Stock Brokers & Sebi Registered Participants operating through these institutions
 - Foreign Consulates are excluded and may take decisions as per their own requirements in view of the international implications.
 - Production, Transportation and Supply Chain, E-commerce of all essential goods including Food, Pharmaceutical, Pest Control and Medical Equipments, Warehousing of all essential food, Grocery, Grain.
5. Asstt. Commissioners and Police to issue advisory to people, not to gather in masses at sea beaches and public places.
 6. Spitting on any public place, premises, road will attract a fine of Rs. 1000/-. Ward Offices Sanitary staff and Police are hereby directed to enforce this punishment strictly.
 7. If there is a doubt about as to whether a service or establishment is essential or not, the Municipal Commissioner shall give a final decision on the same.

Asst. Commissioners of the wards and Zonal Dy.Municipal Commissioners of MCGM and Police Officers appointed by the Commissioner of Police, Mumbai are hereby authorised to take all necessary actions for implementation of the above measures.

Failure to obey these orders shall be penalized under section 188 of I.P.C.
